BILL OF RIGHTS  
AMENDMENT IV

We are blessed, we Americans are, with a national constitution perhaps the finest document ever. There is attached thereto twenty-seven amendments which further define our rights, freedoms, and duties. They only add to the extreme value of this incredible document.

Hear then the words of Amendment IV to our glorious Constitution:

“THE RIGHT OF THE PEOPLE TO BE SECURE IN THEIR PERSONS, HOUSES, PAPERS AND EFFECTS, AGAINST UNREASONABLE SEARCHES AND SEIZURES, SHALL NOT BE VIOLATED, AND NO WARRANTS SHALL ISSUE, BUT UPON PROBABLE CAUSE, SUPPORTED BY OATH OR AFFIRMATION, AND PARTICULARLY DESCRIBING THE PLACE TO BE SEARCHED, AND THE PERSONS OR THINGS TO BE SEIZED.”

So then, we, the people have the RIGHT to be secure. We are to live in safety, protected by and as importantly against intrusions by government, especially the Federal Government. The government can not violate our rights to privacy in our persons, our houses, our papers, and our effects. The Federal Government and all other governments can not violate our rights to be secure in those four categories. Persons, houses, papers, and effects, unconditionally so.

The Federal Government can not invade or intrude. There is inherent in this great Amendment IV the RIGHT TO PRIVACY. Any such violation is a violation of the law and conduct or communication which defies or negates these great protections.

This great Amendment IV requires that the government not invade or intrude our homes, but in fact it does. Surveillance exists everywhere. Cameras are ubiquitous and monitor so much of our daily conduct. More surreptitiously, wire tapes occur commonplace, telephone calls are monitored, and communication thought to be private becomes recorded and public. They can know when they want to know, Big Brother can. We do not know when they, the government, invades and there is little we can do about it.

We are deeply offended and protective if any government invades our houses, or violates our persons. We are ready to do something about that. But there comes in question in today's society where it's high-tech foundation and the IT world in which we live, the intrusion of government, searching and seizing, with regard to matters and categories never considered by our forefathers. The computers of this world contain information, private and public, which dwarfs the information and communication of the past, even that of ten years ago. So much of this information in the world of Yahoo and Google, Facebook and Twitter is public and readily available to that public. But there is little privacy and the government can intrude in so many ways, violating the privacy and SECURITY promised by Amendment IV.

The very same with bank accounts. There are searches at all times, information seized whether by the IRS, welfare agencies, bureaucracies and federal agencies of all kinds. They now have the right to get that information in direct violation and contradiction of Amendment IV. Pilfering social security numbers is rampant along with all of the information of the life and history of the individual. Medical records, HIPAA notwithstanding, can be had by any number of government agencies, the knowledge of which is so extremely destructive to the right to privacy.

And so with the mail, whether regular or junk mail. List upon list which lists us and our information are had by hundreds and thousands of direct marketers and so many others. The papers of today are seized and searched with impunity by governments everywhere. All such activity makes a mockery of Amendment IV and is but another blow to the freedoms we Americans take for granted. So much of that government activity, searching and seizing such information, is illegal and unlawful.

#### IT IS IN DIRECT VIOLATION OF AMENDMENT IV!

Hear then the words again of this great statement of freedom, Amendment IV:

“THE RIGHT OF THE PEOPLE TO BE SECURE IN THEIR PERSONS, HOUSES, PAPERS AND EFFECTS, AGAINST UNREASONABLE SEARCHES AND SIEZURES, SHALL NOT BE VIOLATED.”

The right of we, the people to be secure is unconditional. Stay away from my person, out of my house, and do not violate my papers (computers) and effects, UNCLE SAM. Stay out and away. We are guaranteed such protections and securities by our Amendment IV.

Do not, repeat do not, UNCLE SAM dare to search, investigate, read (text messages), or monitor (internet or telephone) anything we do with our private papers and effects. All such is our business, not yours.

DO NOT VIOLATE THAT RIGHT! Any such violation is not only unconstitutional, it is criminal! YOU, Federal Government, should be prosecuted rather than WE! Stand up, my fellow Americans and protect yourself, your home, your papers, and your effects from government of any kind. That is your right. Demand it, protect it, or lose it. The Federal Government as it is will attempt to erode that great freedom step by step if you

are not diligent and wary. Trust them NOT AT ALL! If your Amendment IV rights are violated, fight back and fight them.
